JANUARY STUDIES

The focus theme for the month of January will be "Winter Wonderland." Your child will be introduced to the concepts of seasonal cold, winter, hibernation, and healthy living. We will continue with the letters K, L, M, and numbers 11 and 12. The colors for the month are white and purple. The shapes are snowflakes and crystals.

Our snowball fights on January 21 and 22 will be in the gym. We use plush balls for the snowballs, so no one gets hurt. The children have lots of fun, and it is great exercise to emphasize healthy living.

To coincide with our hibernation unit, we will have pajama parties on Tuesday, January 28, for the two and three-year-olds and Friday, January 31, for the older students.
